WHAT IS ADVOCACY?

Advocacy listens to young people.

Advocacy can tell you what your rights are.

Advocacy can help you have a voice and be involved in decisions about your life.

Advocacy can help you to explore your opinion and options and to speak out about issues that matter to you!

WHAT DO WE DO AT TGP CYMRU?

TGP Cymru has a few different projects across Wales. Things like advocacy for children and young people, family work and participation groups.

We are also funded by the Welsh Government to help promote, support and update children and young people, Advocates, services and Local Authorities about the National Approach to Statutory Advocacy.

The National Approach is helping to make young people more aware of advocacy and their rights and entitlements.

What is the National Approach and what are the Standards?

Wales has lots of good advocacy services but Welsh Government wants to make sure that all children and young people get the same high level of advocacy service no matter where they live in Wales. There is set of five standards to make sure that this happens:

Standard 1.

Good quality advocacy that's easy to find and easy to use.

Standard 2.

Children and young people are kept safe and have their privacy respected.

Standard 3.

Children and young people are treated with respect and valued for their differences.

Standard 4.

Children and young people get support and have their opinions listed to.

Standard 5.

Children and young people can take part in the design, planning and rating of advocacy services.
