Who are we?

TGP Cymru is a Children's Rights Charity in Wales. We work with children and young people who might want some extra help and support through advocacy.



What we do

TGP Cymru Advocacy Service is a free service for children and young people who are aged 0 - 25 years. It is available to children and young people who have a social worker. It is also available to some children and young people who had a social worker when they were younger.

Advocacy is


- Listening to you •

Important info

TGP Cymru's advocacy service is independent and confidential. That means we do not work for anyone but you and we will not share anything you tell us with others, unless we feel that what you tell us places you or someone else at risk.

The Active Offer


If you have not met an advocate before, this is where an advocate will meet with you and tell you all about advocacy and how it can help. It is then your choice whether you want the advocate to help you. You will get information about advocacy in a pack to keep too.



Issue Based Advocacy

If you have an issue you would like an advocate to help you with, we call it issue based advocacy. Your advocate will help you to work out an issue and when this is done, we will stop working with you. You can get in touch with us again at any time in the future though.

New to TGP Cymru?

If you want to access TGP Cymru's advocacy service, you can contact us. Sometimes other people, like your social worker or teacher might contact us for you, but they have to ask you if this is ok first.

Advocacy is all about you; we will always treat you with respect and we will not ever judge you.



When you start working with us, we will tell you who your advocate is. When you meet your advocate for the first time, they will tell you how you can keep in touch with them.

You can say if you would like a different advocate to the one we give you. You can tell us if you prefer your advocate to be a man or a woman. If you want to speak to your advocate in a language that is not English, you can tell us this too.





Your records

When you have an advocate, they may need to make some notes about you and they may ask you to write your name on a form, which they will explain to you. We call these notes and



forms your file and we keep it very safe. You can ask to look at your file at any time by asking your advocate or getting in touch.
